Minimum Charge = \$10.00

Area Rug (cut in strips no wider than 4 ft.)	\$20.00 each
Carpet – Wall-to-wall	\$20.00 each
Couch	\$20.00 each
Furniture: End table, wooden chairs, dining table, bookcase	\$25.00 each
Loveseat	\$20.00 each
Mattress or Box Spring – ANY size	\$35.00 each
Sink, Toilet	\$20.00 each
Upholstered Chair	\$20.00 each
Doors, Clapboards, Windows, Wood	\$30/half truck load, \$50/full truck load
Fluorescent light bulbs	No charge

Once again Transfer Station “sticker season” is upon us! ***All residents will be required to have the FY2025 sticker affixed to the windshield of their vehicle.***

1. Each household must purchase their own Transfer Station Sticker. “Sharing” stickers or transporting other households’ trash is not allowed. **The transfer station is for residential use only.** No stickers will be sold to/for business use (including landlords).
2. The Transfer Station sticker **MUST** be placed on the lower driver’s side corner of the windshield. Each sticker issued will have the vehicle registration written on it for verification purposes.
3. **Transfer Station Stickers cost \$70. Additional vehicles registered at the same address/household may purchase stickers for \$10 each.** Transfer Station stickers **WILL ONLY** be sold to residents of the Town of Deerfield, no exceptions will be allowed!
4. Transfer Station stickers can be purchased just like last year...Online, Mail or In-person at Transfer Station
Senior Discount – Free Roll of Small Bags or pay \$11 for the Large Bags with 1st sticker purchase
5. All trash must be in Town of Deerfield Trash Bags sold at the Transfer Station (checks only), Leader Lumber, and Neighbors Gas Station on Route 116.
Large bags: \$28, Small bags: \$17
6. The facility is equipped with two paper/cardboard compactors; all residents are urged to seek assistance from the facility attendants when utilizing these machines.
7. Replacement Stickers- Remove the transfer station sticker from your vehicle before you sell or trade your vehicle. If the sticker rips in the process, that’s ok. Send the old sticker to the DPW office by mail for a replacement. No replacement for lost stickers.

Transfer Station Attendants have been instructed to monitor vehicles/residents closely according to these rules and regulations. Non-compliant vehicles/residents **WILL NOT** be allowed to enter the facility. These rules, regulations, and policies need to be implemented for the facility to operate successfully. Your cooperation and mindfulness will make this facility a pleasant experience for all, thank you.
